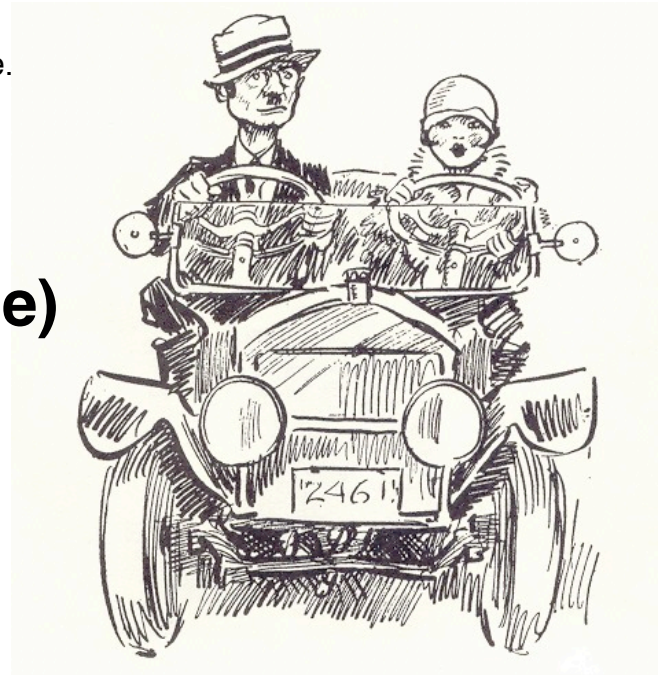

SWAP MEET RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Move-in is from Noon to 8:00 PM Friday and 7:00-7:45 AM on Saturday.
2. Only Vendors with Vendor Badges worn in plain sight will be allowed in the buildings during the move-in periods.
3. We suggest that you be on hand each morning at the opening hour to protect your own goods. Vendors will be allowed in at 7:00 AM on Saturday and Sunday.
4. Bring your own tables. We supply space only, no other accommodations. A limited number of tables are available for renting from the Fairgrounds.
5. No food or drink items of any kind may be sold without prior permission from the Fairgrounds Concessionaire.
6. NO MOTOR VEHICLES are permitted in the Pavilion building. A limited number of trailers can be wheeled in under human power; prior approval required. All other merchandise MUST be wheeled in on pallets or hand trucks.
7. In the other buildings, please unload your vehicle as quickly as possible to facilitate others. All vehicles must be out of the buildings by 7:30 AM Saturday morning. No vehicles will be allowed to remain in the buildings overnight or during Swap Meet hours.
8. This is an Automobile Swap Meet first and foremost, not a flea market. We reserve the right to refuse service or access to anyone.
9. Each Vendor is responsible for their tax liability.
10. Each vendor is responsible for clean-up of their own space.
11. Vendor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Olympic Vintage Auto Club and individual members from any and all costs and expenses by reason of any claim concerning the quality or title to any part or item sold or traded by Vendor.
12. Stall fees are for the weekend or any part thereof. Spaces not claimed by 8:00 AM Saturday may be resold with no refund. No refunds will be made on cancellations after 72 hours before the event.
13. There is NO SMOKING in any building.
14. NO PETS are allowed in any building.

DIRECTIONS

FROM EDMDS-KINGSTON FERRY:

- Debark the ferry onto SR104; it becomes Bond Rd.
- Continue on Bond to the traffic signal at SR305 in Poulsbo.
- Turn RIGHT on SR305; this joins SR3.
- Follow SR3 S to East Bremerton/Waaga Way exit.
- Continue on Waaga Way to Central Valley Road; exit and turn LEFT at the signal.
- Turn RIGHT onto Fairgrounds Rd at the traffic signal.
- Straight through the 4-way Stop to the Fairgrounds.

FROM BAINBRIDGE ISLAND FERRY:

- Debark the ferry onto SR305.
- Continue on SR305; this joins SR3.
- Follow SR3 S to East Bremerton/Waaga Way exit.
- Continue on Waaga Way to Central Valley Road; exit and turn LEFT at the signal.
- Turn RIGHT onto Fairgrounds Rd at the traffic signal.
- Straight through the 4-way Stop to the Fairgrounds.

FROM SEATTLE-TACOMA:

- From I-5, take SR16 West.
- Past Gorst, take SR3 N.
- Exit at Newberry Hill; turn RIGHT at the traffic signal.
- Proceed into Silverdale; turn RIGHT at the traffic signal onto Bucklin Hill Rd.
- Turn RIGHT at the traffic signal onto Tracyton Blvd.
- Turn LEFT onto Fairgrounds Rd.

FROM BREMERTON FERRY:

- Debark ferry and turn RIGHT onto Washington Street; it becomes 11th St.
- Turn RIGHT onto Warren Ave; it becomes Wheaton Way after the bridge.
- Continue on Wheaton Way, past Sheridan, Sylvan, Riddell, McWilliams.
- Turn LEFT at the traffic signal onto Fairgrounds Road.
- Continue to the Fairgrounds.
